Beginning Sunday January 8th will be reading from Matthew 3:13-17 and exploring John Wesley's sermon "The Marks of the New Birth."


On Sunday January 15th we'll be reading John 1:29-42 and looking at Wesley's sermon "The Difference Between Walking by Sight and Walking by Faith."


