A colleague in ministry shared some helpful tidbits on how to make this Advent season be the very best that it can possibly be. I wanted to

- 1. Commit to a spiritual reading this Advent. Find an Advent reflection, passage of scripture or a spiritual memoir to read through to keep you spiritually grounded.
- 2. Just say no. Advent is richer when it's not overbooked. Give yourself permission to say "no". This is easier said than done. It's difficult to turn down good things, but every "no" means a "yes" to what matters most.
- 3. Choose a special way to give this Advent season. The possibilities are limitless.




Souper Saturday Needs **You!**
