The Board of Directors, staff, children, and families served by the Gingerbread House Bossier / Caddo Children's Advocacy Center, join me in thanking you for your generous charitable donation of \$1,500.00 (Check #4917; received 04/03/17). I apologize for the delay in acknowledging your donation - I just returned from maternity leave.

Through your support we are able to continue offering critically needed services free of charge to child victims of sexual and severe physical abuse in northwest Louisiana. Donations to the Gingerbread House, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, are tax deductible as allowed by law. No goods or services were received in exchange for this donation. Our tax identification number is 72-1390471.

To give you an even better idea of the impact we are able to make in our community as a result of your support, I'd like to share with you our progress in 2016:

- · 766 children received forensic interviews, multidisciplinary investigations, and family advocacy services, averaging 64 forensic interviews per month.
- · 207 child victims & their non-offending caregivers received counseling services.
- · As part of our prevention efforts, over 23,208 children and adults participated in educational outreach sessions.
- · Thanks to the generosity of donors like you, all services were offered free of charge to child victims of abuse and their families.




